You may have read the letters to the editor in the Beacon over the last few months. Most of the letters, but not all, have really blasted the state of the sidewalks, beachfront and the pier.

Thankfully in the Oct. 26th edition of the Beacon, the cover story about the cleanliness of Ocean Beach is pretty much right on. Hope you all read it.

The OBMA spends somewhere in the neighborhood of \$55,000 to \$60,000 per year (much of it coming from the Newport Ave. Maintenance Assessment District) to empty trash (5 times per week), replace trash cans and lids, maintain the landscaping, power wash the sidewalks (once a month), empty the ash cans and sweep the gutters.

Maintaining the commercial district in a beach community is a major challenge and we can use all the help we can get. If all businesses check the front and back of their buildings each day and tidy up, it would be a great addition to what the Association already does. Thanks for your help.


